

North Carolina Absentee Ballot Request

Any registered North Carolina voter can apply for an absentee ballot. A near-relative (defined as a spouse, brother, sister, parent, grandparent, child, grandchild, mother-in-law, father-in-law, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, stepparent, or stepchild) can also apply on behalf of the voter.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: If you registered to vote by mail and you have not yet voted in North Carolina, please include a copy of your identification with this form. Acceptable forms of ID include: current and valid photo ID; current utility bill; bank statement; government check; or other government document showing your name and address. Your identification must show your name and the address at which you are registered to vote.

Please mail your completed application, and a copy of your ID (if application) to your County Board of Elections. To be processed for the next election, your absentee ballot application must be received by your [County Board of Elections](#) prior to the last Tuesday before the election.
