

Wyoming Absentee Ballot Application

There is no official deadline to submit your absentee ballot application, but we recommend submitting your application at least four weeks before the election. If you are voting for the first time in Wyoming, you must include a copy of your ID with your absentee ballot application. Acceptable forms of ID include **one of the following**: a driver's license from any state; an ID card issued by a local, state or federal agency; a US passport; a school ID; or a military ID. If you do not have any of those options, you may include **two of the following**: Certification of US Citizenship, Certificate of Naturalization, Draft Record, voter registration card from another state or county, original or certified copy of a birth certificate bearing an official seal, certification of birth abroad issued by the Department of State, or any other form of identification issued by an official agency.

Mail your completed application to your County Clerk. Your county clerk will verify your information and mail you an absentee ballot: You can find the mailing addresses here: <http://soswy.state.wy.us/Elections/CountyClerks.aspx>.
